Qualifications

Instructors must possess an Associate of Arts degree and six-years experience or a Bachelor's degree and two-years experience. Some subjects require instructor certification per POST regulation 10-70 (i.e. Defensive Tactics, Firearms, Driving, CPR, Hazardous Materials, Racial Profiling, PT). All instructors must complete a POST Academy Instructor Certification Course (AICC) prior to submission of an application.
