

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This is a 40-hour course designed for patrol officers, investigators and crime prevention personnel, who desire to develop an expertise in the area of rural crime. The student will be provided with skills necessary for effective rural crime prevention, reporting, interdiction and investigation.

The course includes instruction on basic livestock theft investigation, breed and brand recognition, individual case studies, rural criminal law, trespass law, the bureau of livestock identification's role and responsibilities, livestock road enforcement, agricultural commodity theft, investigation and inspection, heavy equipment theft, agricultural fraud, equipment OAN and PIN number identification, metal theft, animal fighting and agricultural chemical theft.

Lecture-related field exercises and role playing are included in this course. Related law enforcement professionals are invited to attend.
