

*Senior Instructor*

Jim Frawley is the Fire Chief for the Santa Cruz Fire Department. Chief Frawley started his fire service career with the Glendale Fire Department in 1989. There he served as a Firefighter, Paramedic, Engineer and Captain. In these assignments, he gained a diverse amount of expertise serving in roles that involved Hazardous Materials, Weapons of Mass Destruction, Disaster Planning and Management, Public Education and Public Information. Chief Frawley assumed command of the San Marino Fire Department in 2012 and then was appointed as Fire Chief of the San Gabriel, San Marino, and South Pasadena Fire Departments in 2014. His responsibilities included the development and coordination of a Shared Fire Command Staff as well as being an active member of the Executive Team for the Cities of San Gabriel, San Marino, and South Pasadena. First among the Los Angeles Area fire departments, this sharing of Command resources was a revolutionary change in the way fire and paramedic services are managed.

Chief Hall is the Assistant Fire Chief for the Central Fire District of Santa Cruz County.
