### Do you qualify?

If you meet ANY of the entrance qualifications listed below, ABC will accept your application for the next Agent Trainee/Agent exam in July 2017.

### Qualifications:

- Any Bachelor's Degree (early entry to exam for students in their senior year of college);
- Two years of experience as a peace officer performing investigative work as part of their regular enforcement activity.
- Two years of college (60 semester units) with a major in criminal justice, law enforcement, criminology, administration of justice, or police science (early entry to exam for students who have completed 30 units in college with at least 9 units in criminal justice, law enforcement, criminology, administration of justice or police science);
- High School diploma and two years of active duty military service performing law enforcement or security functions;
- High School diploma and graduation from a POST-certified police academy
