

CITY OF RIDGECREST Job Announcement

Lateral Police Officer/Academy Graduates or Current Academy Enrollees

Salary: \$4234 - \$5404 per month plus benefits and incentives. The applicant's experience and qualifications determine appointment level.

Duties: The Ridgecrest Police Department provides a wide range of professional law enforcement functions to the community. Assignments may include criminal investigation, community relations, uniformed patrol, traffic enforcement, narcotic investigations, K-9 Unit, or any other duties expected of an experienced police officer.

Minimum Requirements:

- Age:** Must be a minimum of 21 years of age.
Education: Must possess a high school diploma or equivalent.
Fitness: Vision must be correctable to 20/30
Applicant must pass a P.O.S.T. approved medical and psychological exam.
Experience: Completion of P.O.S.T. approved basic academy and/or been employed by a California Law Enforcement Agency within one (1) year of application date to qualify for a "pre-service" position.
Certification: If applicable, a copy of the applicant's P.O.S.T. Basic Certificate must accompany the application. A California Driver's License must be obtained prior to appointment.

Testing: The testing procedure consists of a written exam, which may be waived, with verification of P.O.S.T. Certification or educational degrees, an oral board interview. Each process counts as 50% of the total score and establishes a ranking order. The physical ability test, background, polygraph, psychological and medical examinations are scored on a pass or fail basis.

Facility: The Police Department Facility is located in the Civic Center, built in 1990, at 100 West California Avenue, which includes a Community Center with basketball courts, gymnastic equipment, aerobics, and two racquetball courts.

Benefits: The City of Ridgecrest provides employees a tiered cafeteria plan with a minimum of \$575.00 per month to purchase medical, dental and life insurance. A tuition reimbursement plan is available, as is incentive pay from 5% to 12.5% for certain P.O.S.T. Certificates or academic degrees held or obtained while employed by the City of Ridgecrest. New employees earn a minimum of 80 hours vacation, 104 hours of sick and 11 regular holidays plus 48 hours of floating holiday time annually. Officers receive \$1200.00 annual uniform allowance; a City paid Life Insurance equal to \$50,000 or one times annual salary whichever is greater; and other bonus pays as negotiated by the Police Employee Association of Ridgecrest (PEAR).
