





## Veteran Benefits – College of San Mateo Student Application Process for Basic Academy

**NOTE:** Prerequisites for Basic Police Academy include passing scores on Entrance Assessment Exams. More info and scheduling <u>can be found here</u>.

- 1) Contact our main office at 408-229-4299 to ensure there is space available in the class before continuing with the instructions on this page.
- 2) Complete the registration process by following the <u>CSM College instructions</u>. You will need to wait for and submit both ID numbers (OpenCCC AND CSM College) according to the instructions on that page in order to be considered as registered.
- Complete the VA application for benefits at <u>www.gibill.va.gov</u>; scroll down and click on Apply for Benefits. Be sure to print two copies of the completed application: one for your records and one for the CSM Certifying Official – OR – provide a copy of your VA Certificate of Eligibility.
- 4) Obtain a copy of your <u>DD214</u>.
- 5) Complete the Enrollment Data Request (EDR) and Statement of Responsibility.

Present all documents to the VA Certifying Official at CSM, located in Building 10, 3<sup>rd</sup> floor, Admissions & Records. If any of the above items are missing. the VA Certifying Official will not be able to certify you.
