Damage Inspection Specialist (DINS)

Class Description:

This course is designed to provide the skills and knowledge needed to perform in the role of a Damage Inspection Specialist. Topics include position overview; supplies and equipment; assignments; Damage Inspection Manager (DINM) expectations; communications; documentation; navigation; safety, and data collection.

Prerequisites:

Introduction to Incident Command System (IS-100); and ICS for Single Resources and Initial Action Incidents (IS-200.b); and National Incident Management System (NIMS), An Introduction (IS-700.a); and Basic Land Navigation (NWCG) (PMS-475), plus <u>one</u> of the following:

- o Fire Fighter I; or
- CAL FIRE Basic Fire Fighter (minimum of 67-hour course); or
- Firefighter Training (NWCG) (S-130); or
- o Incident Safety Awareness for Hired Vendors, State Fire Training
