Course Overview

This training program will briefly cover basic communicable diseases, transmission principles and prevention strategies related to the EMS environment. After a brief overview, we will transition into the Designated Officer responsibilities, the laws and regulations that govern that role and provide guidelines to have an effective communicable disease plan. Special attention will be given to California laws and regulations. The course will take participants through the steps of setting up a communicable disease management program and give them hands on practice at exploring a communicable disease exposure and designing an effective post exposure plan.
