FIRE ACADEMY PREP CLASS

DESCRIPTION:

The Fire Academy Prep Class is intended to assist potential Fire Academy recruits in preparing for the South Bay Regional Fire Academy. The Prep Class will focus on: physical fitness requirements; academy course curriculum & work load; policy & procedures manual; Learning Management System; uniform and grooming standards; site and facility familiarization; pre-employment preparation, resume's, background investigations, physical fitness testing prep, general fire service testing process. This course is intended to help students with being successful in the Fire Academy and in pursuing their fire service careers.

Note to persons attending the Fire Academy: Although not required for Fire Academy #40, the Fire Academy Prep class will be offered sequentially to a cohort of students. Any enrollment space available at the conclusion of the Fire Academy Prep Class for the Fire Academy will be on a first come first serve basis.
