

# S-290 INTERMEDIATE WILDLAND FIRE BEHAVIOR

#### **COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

This is classroom-based skills course designed to prepare the prospective fireline supervisor to undertake safe and effective fire management operations. It is the second course in a series that collectively serves to develop fire behavior prediction knowledge and skills. Fire environment differences are discussed as necessary; instructor should stress local conditions.

S-190

This class is a pre-requisite for S-230/S-231 (Crew/Engine Boss – Single Resource), S-234 (Ignition Ops), S-330 (Task Force/Strike Team Leader) and S-390 (Intro to Wildland Fire Behavior Calculations)
