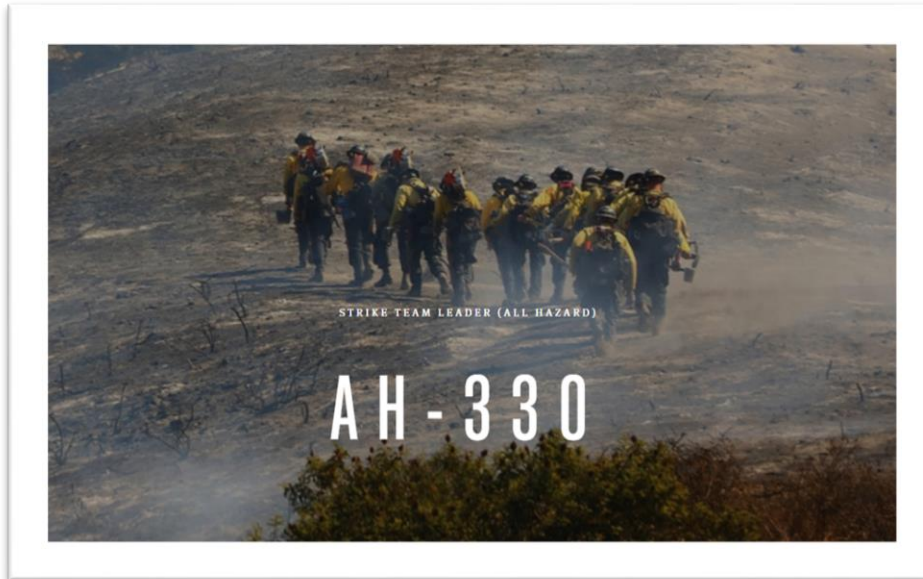


SANTA CRUZ COUNTY TRAINING OFFICERS GROUP

STRIKE TEAM LEADER AH-330 (ALL HAZARD) COURSE



COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course is required training for qualification as a Strike Team or Task Force Leader, under the California Incident Command Certification System (CICCS). This course is designed to provide the skills and knowledge needed to perform in the position of Strike Team/Task Force Leader. Topics include position overview; pre-deployment responsibilities; concept of the position; resource typing standards; pre-dispatch preparation; incident responsibilities; administration; supervision; response; assignment; demobilization; tactics and safety; risk management; entrapment avoidance; WUI; case studies; scenarios; appropriate action vs. freelancing.

PREREQUISITE: CICCS Qualified Engine Boss, Heavy Equipment Boss or Crew Boss; I-300 and S-290 (Classroom version)
